

## **FEE STRUCTURE**

Our fees include tuition, text books, outings and intings and school based extra murals/sports – tennis, netball, hockey, soccer, cricket, athletics and chess. Subject specialist tutoring in high school. We have a resident Counsellor who offers counselling to students in need.

We offer a sibling discount of 5% for 2<sup>nd</sup> child, 10% for 3<sup>rd</sup> child and 30% for 4<sup>th</sup> child.

Please bear in mind that a full terms notice is required should you leave the school in order to receive any refunds.

Once we receive this the fully completed Application form an assessment will be arranged and Primary School student will spend the day and do the assessment at the same time. High School student will come and sit the Entrance Assessment, which normally take 2 – 3 hours.

Should the student meet our academic requirements and a space is available, only then will a Letter of Offer be sent by the Principal. At this point the Registration Fee and Deposit would become due.

No foreign student will be allowed to study without a valid **Study Visa**. No student will be allowed to study if the fees are not up to date.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**Assessment:** We assess all students before they are offered a position at the school. The reason for assessment is to ascertain not only the academic level of the student but also j c the emotional level.

**Bursary:** We do not offer Bursaries.

**Class No:** Nursery 15 per class. Pre-reception – Reception 22 per class. Y1 – Y6 24 per class  
Y7 – Y13 25 per class

**Curriculum:** We follow the Cambridge Curriculum

**Discounts:** We offer 5% for 2<sup>nd</sup> child, 10 for 3<sup>rd</sup> child and 30% for 4<sup>th</sup> child

**Exams:** Year 3 –6 Progression test

Year 10 IGCSE's (Internal General Certificate of Senior Education)

Year 12 As Level (Advanced Subsidiary)

Year 13 A Level (Advanced) optional. Would be needed to enter foreign University

- Exam Costs:** Can be seen on our fee structure under Additional Costs and Levies
- Languages:** We offer English, Afrikaans, Spanish and German. Afrikaans is compulsory in Junior school (unless an exemption is applied for and granted). High school you have the choice of what second language you would like to study. Second language can be dropped after completion of Year 10.
- Levy:** A R1000 annual Development Levy will be deducted from your Deposit eg; should a student spend 10 years at our school you would receive R5000.00 back from the R15000.00 deposit, which you paid at inception.
- Lunch:** Lunch is provided for Pre-Reception and Reception.
- Notice Period:** One full terms notice is required if you intend removing your child from school. Failing which the following terms fees will become due.
- Scholarship:** We do not offer Scholarships.
- Stationery:** Stationery and workbooks are for parents account.
- Sport:** Cricket, Netball, Soccer, Tennis, Athletics, Junior
- Text Books:** Supplied school
- Uniforms:** Purchased through Hatricks, however, tried on at our Uniform Shop.
- Year Groups:** Classes start from Nursery School (student must turn 3 by 30 June) until Year 12. Optional Year 13 when students can enrol for A Levels. We refer to a Grade as Year eg; Grade 1 = Year 1. Child would need to turn 6 by 30 June in order to enter Grade/Year 1.
